This year's event has accepted TTR 2 star status for the snowboarders, a further benefit the snowboard competitors.

After an initial setback for the Lecht leg of the series the outlook is looking good for the Nevis Range event on the 14th March. A recent cold snap has induced good old Mother Nature into providing a flurry of white stuff in anticipation for next weekend.

The comp itself will be 2 runs in the heats to get your steez on. Best on show will be taken through to the finals which also consist of 2 runs – best score wins.
