## Organisation

This event is being organised by Snowsport England, with assistance from The Snow Centre, Hemel.

## Competition Format and Entry Criteria

### Non-Seeded Competition

This event is a non-seeded individual moguls competition, consisting of a minimum of two runs down the same course, and is open to Home Nation registered skiers of both genders and in all age categories. Prizes will be awarded based on the single best combined run score, which will be judged on the basis of 66.6% turns & technique and 33.3% air.

There will be one jump used for judging air, located at the bottom of the course.

### Unregistered Competitors

## Race Entry and Refunds

Entry fee for this event is £50.

Entries close 7pm on **Wednesday 15th July**. Late entries may be accepted at an additional fee of £10.00.

Race entry fees are non-refundable, except for from racers withdrawing on medical grounds, who may obtain a £25 refund of their entry fee if they apply to the Race Secretary and provide certified medical evidence to support their application.

## Awards

Awards will be made in the following categories:

### Grom - Born in 2015 and younger

Girls: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>,  
Boys: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>,

### Youth – Born from 2014 to 2011

Women: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>,  
Men: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>,

### Junior – Born from 2010 to 2006

Women: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>,  
Men: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>,

### Senior – Born from 2005 and older

Women: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>,  
Men: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>,

The winners will be expected to show due courtesy to the organisers by attending the prize giving. Those who do not attend without good reason lose their claim to an award.

## Start Order

The start order will be drawn on Saturday 18th July, in gender and age group order.

The start order will run from lowest bib number upwards, and will run in the same order for all runs.

Any competitor who DNFs on a run is still entitled to take part in subsequent runs.

Competitors do not need to start all runs in order to be eligible for final rankings.

Start lists will be published in the official WhatsApp group on competition day.

## Race Rules and Health and Safety

The competition will be run under FIS rules (ICR) as varied by GB Snowsport (BACR) and Snowsport England. Links to rules and guide books are listed below, all racers and coaches are encouraged to make themselves familiar with these documents:

Access to the slope is for officials, accredited coaches and competitors only. Spectators must watch from in the bar area or on the viewing platform.

During official open practice bibs, must be carried on the person of competitors. Skiers without a bib will be asked to leave the slope.

Helmets and gloves must be worn by anyone on slope at any time.

## Competition Office

The competition office will be located at the top of the stairs at The Snow Centre, Hemel, from 17.00 on the 18<sup>th</sup> July.

## Photography

Racers who do **not** wish to be photographed by any accredited photographer must notify the Chief of Competition, in writing, by the end of race registration. Alternatively, please email Snowsport England in advance if you do not wish to be photographed. Any official photographs or video may be used for promotional purposes for both the event and wider Snowsport England promotion.

## Officials

Please note competitions can only run with sufficient officials. If you can assist, or would like to shadow a particular role, or learn more about officiating, please contact the Chief of Competition.

## Timetable Updates

Timetable updates, along with any other important information, will be published in the event WhatsApp group throughout the day.

## Bibs

Bibs must be returned to the finish marshal on completion of the final run of competition. Failure to do so will result in a charge of £50 for each missing bib.

## First Aid

First Aid cover will be available throughout the day by members of the event staff and by staff from The Snow Centre, Hemel.
